Artists have the opportunity to exhibit their artwork in our Lee Adams Florida Artist Gallery. This space will be dedicated to the work of three artists who will exhibit together over one of three four-month time period:

- July - October
- November - February
- March - June

If you are interested in exhibiting, please read our guidelines and fill out the following application.

GUIDELINES

- Artist will sign a contract with Thrasher-Horne Center and St. Johns River State College.
- Artist must have 10-15 pieces (depending on size) ready to hang prior to selection and must be able to replenish sold pieces within two weeks of sale.
- Artist must offer artwork with varying price points. At least one piece must be priced under \$1000.
- All artwork must be sold through the Thrasher-Horne Box Office.
- All artwork will remain in the gallery for the four-month exhibit (unless sold).
- Artist must commit to attending the Thursday at Thrasher event schedule during their exhibition.

What is Thursday at Thrasher? Thursday at Thrasher is a free tri-annual community event that will showcase the local artists currently displayed in our galleries. Each featured gallery artist will give a talk-back about their work on display. Additional music, food, craft and art vendors will also be invited to host tables in the lobby during this evening.
