As we look towards our new season, Thrasher-Horne Center will be adhering to innovative yet strict physical distancing measures and following the latest recommended guidelines.

Committed to your safety, we are selling a limited number of tickets for our events in a socially distanced auditorium. Additional seats may open later as guidelines change.

Here's a look at some of the measures we have put into place:

- We are reducing audience capacity to increase the physical distances between seating groups and to minimize close contact with other guests in your row.
- All seats are currently being sold online in pairs. However, additional seats may be purchased with your group by calling the ticket office at (904) 276-6815 ext. 1.
- Our staff is disinfecting and cleaning seats, armrests, countertops, restrooms and other high-touch surfaces before, during and after performances.
- We have added floor markings and one way directional arrows throughout the Center to help promote appropriate social distancing.
- All food and drink from concessions, when available, will be consumed either in the auditorium at your seat, or outside of the Center.
- For additional peace of mind, we have updated our ticket policies to allow tickets to be exchanged for an account credit when done at least 48 hours prior to the original performance.

Play Your Part! - Health and Safety Protocols

In order to offer the safest, most enjoyable experience possible during these times, the following changes will be in effect going forward. We appreciate everyone's patience and understanding as we navigate through these new protocols together.

To Enter Thrasher-Horne Center:

1. Face coverings are required.
2. Wash and sanitize hands often. There are sanitizing stations placed in multiple locations throughout Thrasher-Horne Center.
3. Practice physical distancing and keep at least 6 feet between your party and others. We ask guests to not congregate unnecessarily in public areas.
4. Avoid contact with people who are sick prior to visiting Thrasher-Horne Center. Guests should evaluate their risk in determining whether to attend or take advantage of our updated ticket policy if necessary.
